

**Notice and Agenda of the  
Special Meeting of Members of the  
African Consortium for Law and Religion Studies  
To Consider Adopting an Amendment to the  
Amended and Restated Constitution of the  
African Consortium for Law and Religion Studies**

**19 May 2026**

A special meeting of members of the African Consortium for Law and Religion Studies (“ACLARS”) will be held to consider adopting an amendment to the current ACLARS Constitution (the “Amended and Restated Constitution of the African Consortium for Law and Religion Studies”). The special meeting will be convened at or shortly after 13:30 on Tuesday 19 May 2026, or as soon thereafter as reasonably possible, in the Serena Hotel Luncheon Tent (immediately outside the hotel) in Kigala, Rwanda. The special meeting will be held as part of the meeting of the General Assembly of members of ACLARS that is being held at the indicated time and place in conjunction with the 2026 ACLARS Conference held at the Serena Hotel in Kigale, Rwanda from May 17-19, 2026.

A copy of the proposed amendment is provided with this Notice. During the special meeting, the proposed amendment shall be discussed, and further revisions can be made at the meeting. In order to amend the ACLARS constitution, a resolution proposing the amendment must be passed by at least two-thirds of those present and voting (counting both those who are physically present and those who have proxies authorizing them to cast votes on behalf of others). Those present at the meeting may cast their own vote and no more than two proxy votes, provided that the Board of Directors confirms the validity of proxy authorization.

The change proposed by resolution shall be sent within ten days to all members of the Organisation at the last email address on record for them with the Secretary of ACLARS. The proposed amendment shall go into effect and shall remain in effect unless one-third of the members on record submit written objections to the amendment by email to [secretariat@aclars.org](mailto:secretariat@aclars.org) within thirty (30) days of the time the notice of proposed amendment is emailed to them.
